


How do I use the Kaltura Video Editor?


The Kaltura Video Editor is an online editing tool you can use to edit videos you have captured or uploaded with Kaltura My Media

Follow these steps to edit a video --

Open the video in My Media




Under the video click the "ACTIONS" tab and choose "Launch Editor"



NOTE: be sure to choose "Launch Editor" rather than "Edit"

"Edit" will let you to edit information about the video, whereas "Launch Editor" will let you edit the video itself.

The Kaltura Video Editor will open



Use the Play button to play and pause the video. Use the left and right arrows to jump to the beginning or end of the video



The Real Time Marker shows where you are in the video's timeline



Click and drag the Zoom slider to zoom into or out of parts of the timeline



Click the Audio icon to select an audio track (if you have more than one)



Click the Undo and Redo icons to undo and redo edits




Click the Reset icon to undo all edits and revert to the original video



How do I trim footage from the beginning and end of a video?

[Open a video in the Kaltura Video Editor](#) and follow these steps to remove footage from the beginning and end of a video --


Move the Real Time Marker to where you would like the new beginning of the video to be




If needed, use the Zoom slider to zoom into or out of parts of the timeline, for more precise placement of the Real Time Marker




Click the "[" icon to mark the new in-point for the video



Move the Real Time Marker to where you would like the new end of the video to be



Click the "]" icon to mark the new out-point for the video




The video will now be highlighted in yellow with the new in-points and out-points

How do I remove footage from within a video?

[Open a video in the Kaltura Video Editor](#) and follow these steps to remove footage from the middle of a video --

Move the Real Time Marker to the "in-point" of the footage you would like to remove




If needed, use the Zoom slider to zoom into or out of parts of the timeline, for more precise placement of the Real Time Marker




Click the Scissors icon to create a "split" at that in-point



Move the Real Time Marker to the "out-point" of the footage you would like to remove




Click the Scissors icon again to place a "split" at that out-point



Click on the section of video you would like to remove to insure that it's highlighted in yellow



Press "Delete" on your keyboard to delete that section of video. It will no longer be shown in the timeline.



Repeat the steps above to remove other sections of video as needed.


If needed, you can use the Undo and Redo buttons to undo or redo edits



You can also use the Reset icon to cancel all edits and return to the original version of the video



When you have finished removing sections of footage, click "Save a Copy" to save the edited copy of the video



Enter a title and click "Create". The edited video will then be available in Kaltura My Media
