#### Why study abroad?

- To complement your studies
- To strengthen your ability to work in a different cultural environment
- To strengthen your professional language skills
- To build up a professional network
- To make friends from around the world

... remember that student exchange is more than travelling!



## STEP 1

# PLAN YOUR STUDIES



#### You can be selected, if...



- 1. You are a degree seeking student and enrolled as present (läsnäoleva) at the time of applying
- 2. You have progressed normally in your studies according to your PSP (30 ects per semester, max. 120 ects)
- You have not
  - declined an offered exchange place after earlier application rounds, or
  - cancelled your exchange after accepting the place
- 4. You meet;
  - Degree programme-specific rules and recommendations (<u>check appropriate time</u> for the Exchange)
  - Special requirements set by a partner institution or Haaga-Helia
  - Haaga-Helia's GPA requirements
- 5. Student exchange does not prolong your graduation
  - You must complete approximately 30 ECTS credits on exchange
- 6. You are able to study in the language of tuition



## STEP 2

# FIND YOUR DESTINATION

#### Things to consider

- 1. Personal and cultural motives / interests
- 2. Study and career related motives
- 3. Language of tuition

#### Consider also

- Local culture and your ability to adapt into it
- Health, Special diets (Vegan, Gluten-free etc.)
- Budget
- Time and effort you are willing to invest in the process
- Safety





#### **Partner institutions**

- 200 partner universities around the world
- You may apply for destinations which are open for your degree programme and study level
- Find student exchange destinations and student exchange reports in <u>MoveON</u>
- Also check out
  - Host institution's website for incoming exchange students
  - Tips from incoming exchange students to Haaga-Helia

#### **Costs**

- No tuition fees
  - Exceptions are mentioned clearly in <u>MoveON</u> (destination database)
- Costs a student will be responsible for
  - Extra study related fees (eg. language courses, orientation)
  - Administrative fees
  - IELTS, TOEFL i.e. Language certificates → only if required
  - Accommodation (incl. rent, deposit, electricity, water, kitchenware...)
  - Costs for travelling, insurance, visa, residence permit
  - Vaccinations and health certificates
  - Study materials



### **Funding**

- Study grant + housing supplement + government guaranteed student loan from KELA
- Haaga-Helia's <u>student exchange grant</u>
  - Erasmus+ (EU countries)
  - Bilateral (countries outside of EU)
- Your own savings
- Other sources of income and grants
  - Find out on your own





## STEP 3

## APPLY



### **Application in MoveON**

- This is not a speed

  Contest!

  All applications submitted
  by the deadline are

  treated equally!
- MoveON application form is open during each application period
- Before you begin, take your time to read the instructions carefully
  - The application doesn't require any attachments or motivation letters
- You can apply for 1-6 host institutions
  - Make your choices before starting to fill the application
  - Select only destinations where you want to go to
  - Put the destinations into order of preference
- Before submitting the form check that the information is correct! You can't make any changes to the application after submitting it!
- MoveON will generate a PDF-copy of the submitted online application, keep it safe on your device

#### **Choose your destinations wisely!**

- You will only get one offer and it can't be changed
- If you do not accept the seat offered, or cancel the accepted seat later on, you will not be eligible to apply again to student exchange



### **GPA** requirement

- If you meet the general criteria, selection to destinations is made on the basis of **GPA shown in Peppi** and order of priority
- All studies which are graded in Peppi when the application period closes count towards the GPA
- There are no other criteria for students which would give additional points


#### → Always check the destination specific GPA requirement from MoveON!

- 3.0 for most destinations
- 2.5 in some destinations in Europe
- 3.75 in some destinations

### Language requirements

Evaluate your skills in all the required languages before submitting an online application

- You can use online tests as reference, like <u>Self-evaluate your language skills</u>
- You can apply <u>Europass criteria</u> for estimating your level in a language




#### Why is it important to do self-evaluating?

You apply for an Italian partner institution and fail to evaluate your knowledge in Italian, not meeting the language requirements, your application to that institution will not be processed. You need to be able to study in the language of the host institution's studies, to successfully pass the courses.

#### **Application deadlines**

- Deadline for submitting your online application on first application round
  - $\rightarrow$  5.2.2023 at 23:59 (local Finnish time)
- Deadline for submitting your online application on second application round
  - → 11.3.2023 at 23:59 (local Finnish time)
- Deadline for submitting your online application on third application round
  - → 2.9.2023 at 23:59 (local Finnish time)
- Late or incomplete applications will not be processed
- Do not leave it till the last minute!





# AFTER APPLYING

#### **Selection results and orientation**

Selections will be published

• **First** application round → 16.2.2024

Second application round  $\rightarrow$  22.3.2024

• **Third** application round → 13.9.2024

All applicants will be contacted via email

→ Note that you will receive only **one** offer and it can't be changed!

Selected students will be invited to compulsory orientation
